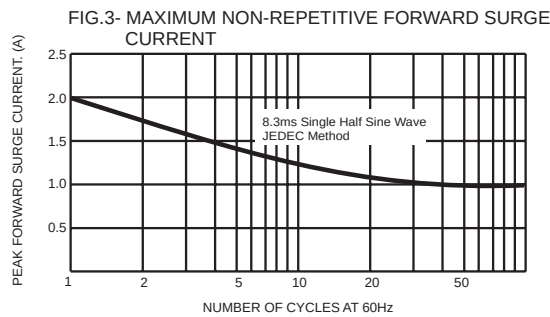
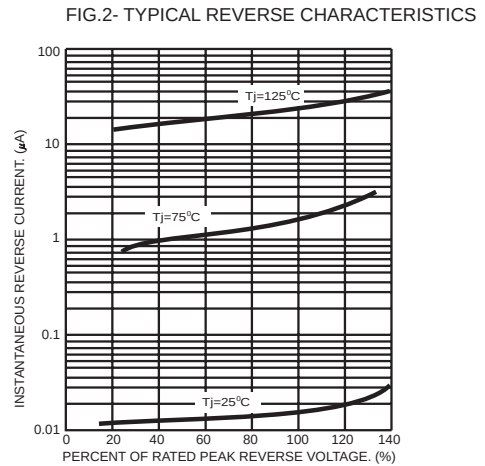
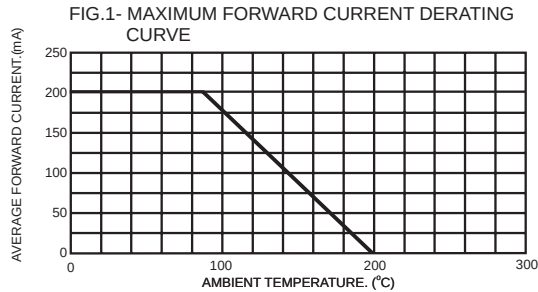


FIG.5- TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

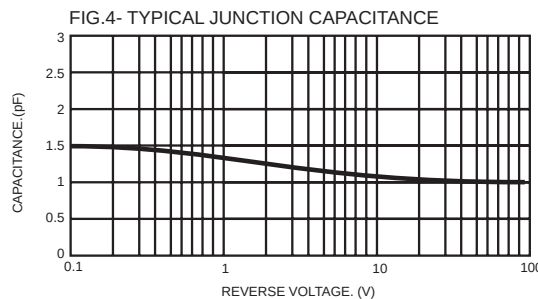
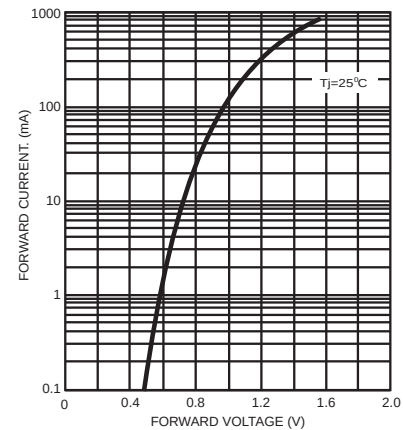


FIG.6- REVERSE RECOVERY TIME CHARACTERISTIC AND TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM
